The Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) limited to MTS officials and Competitive Examination limited to GDSs is scheduled to be held on 14th November, 2021 (Sunday) for recruitment/promotion to the cadre of Postman and Mail Guard for the vacancy year 2021 (01.01.2021 to 31.12.2021). - 3. <u>Eligibility Criteria</u>: As per the Department of Posts Postman and Mail Guard (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2018 notified in GSR 899 (E) dated 20.09.2018 read with Postman and Mail Guard (Group 'C post) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2020 notified in GSR 157 (E) dated 05.03.2020, the following categories of official(s) are eligible to appear in the examination:
 - (i) Multi Tasking Staff (MTS) in Level-I of the pay matrix with three years regular service in the grade as on 01.01.2021. However, in accordance with Directorate's letter No. W-17/16/2021-SPN-I dated 20.09.2021, the relaxation in eligibility service for the vacancy year 2021 will be available as under:

- (a) Educational Qualification: 10th standard pass from a recognized Board.
- (b) Age: Maximum age as on 01.01.2021 for UR candidates shall be 50 years, for SC/ST will be 55 and for OBC is 53.
- (c) The candidate should have studied local language at least upto 10th standard. Local language of the Postal/RMS Division falling under Punjab State/UT Chandigarh as per Directorate's Notification No. 17-08/2018-SPB-I dated 10.05.2019 is as under:-

- (d) Know ledge of working on Computer.
- (e) The person appointed to the post of Postman shall have/acquire a driving license to drive two wheeler or three wheeler or light motor vehicle within a period of two years from the date of his appointment. However, persons with disability shall be exempted from the requirement of driving licence. A candidate not having valid driving licence at the time of appointment shall not earn periodical increment in pay till production of such licence or for a period of five years from the date of appointment whichever is earlier and after production of such licence or expiry' of such five years period, pay shall be restored prospectively to the level pay would have reached had the periodical increment in pay was not withheld and no arrears of pay shall be paid for the intervening period. [This condition is required for recruitment to the cadre of Postman only]

Note:

- (i) Candidate belonging to Postal Division shall clearly indicate order of preference in Application form for Postal Divisions excluding Parent Division followed by RMS Divisions.
- (ii) Candidate belonging to RMS division shall clearly indicate order of preference in Application form for RMS Divisions excluding Parent Division followed by Postal Divisions.
- (iii) Candidate must exercise preference for all Recruiting Units for consideration in the proforma at **Annexure-II.** In case preference is exercised for a limited number of units and could not be allocated to one of those units as per merit vis-a-vis vacancy in the category he/she belongs to, he/she will not be considered for other recruiting units not preferred even though a candidate lower in rank to him/her is considered who has opted for that unit.
- (iv) Order of preference (as per Annexure-II) once exercised shall not be changed.
- 4. Pattern & Syllabus of Examination: The examination will be conducted as per the revised pattern and syllabus circulated by Directorate vide letter No. 17-08/2018-SPB-I dated 10.05.2019 under Annexure-'B' read with letter dated 10.06.2019, 20.06.2019. 26.06.2019, 28.06.2019,11.07.2019, 23.07.2019 and letter No. 17-08/2018-SPN-I dated 09.09.2021, enclosed as Annexure-III.

Note: The 'Skill test of data entry' will be conducted subsequently as per the instructions issued in the Broad guidelines (**Annexure B**) of Directorate letter No 34012/01/2021-DE dated 11/03/2021.

- 5. <u>Centres of Examination:</u> The examination will be conducted at all Circle Headquarters/Region only. The candidates will have to appear from the respective centres of their Circle only and under no circumstances, they be permitted to appear from other Circle Centres.
- 6. The application of the APS candidates should be sent to the concerned Divisions only and not to Circle office.
- 7. This notification may be given wide publicity amongst all eligible candidates working in Divisions/Units.
- 8. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.



In continuation of letter of even number dated 10.05.2019, read with letter of even number dated 10.06.2019, on the above mentioned subject, the Competent Authority has approved further modifications in Annexure B, Annexure C and Annexure D of the letter dated 10.05.2019 as specified below:

- I. Point No. II of both Annexure B and Annexure C, relating to criteria for selection, shall be replaced with the following:
- (i) Examination for Paper I and Paper II will be conducted in continuity.
- (ii) Out of the candidates who secure qualifying marks in both Paper I and Paper II separately, the number of candidates to be shortlisted for appearing in Paper III shall be 3 to 5 times the number of vacancies.
- (iii) Candidates who qualify in Paper III shall be considered for final selection and their merit shall be drawn in order of marks secured in Paper I. Since Paper III and Paper III are only qualifying, marks secured in Paper III and Paper III shall not be added to marks secured in Paper I to decide merit.
- (iy) After arranging the candidates in order of merit as at (iii) above, number of candidates to be declared successful shall be equal to the number of vacancy in each category.
- (y) In the event of any vacancy notified for recruitment remains unfilled only due to non-joining of selected candidate, the next candidate in the merit list in the same category shall be considered for appointment. However, appointment of such candidate shall be only on the ground of refusal of promotion / declining offer of appointment and no wait list or approved panel shall be maintained.
